Mike Ball is an author, an Erma Bombeck award-winning humor columnist, an accomplished singer-songwriter... and a former world champion pairs water skier. That water skier stuff is irrelevant, but it's true and kind of cool.

He's also the founder and Executive Director of Lost Voices. Since 2006 Mike's group of professional singer-songwriters have brought therapeutic songwriting interventions to teenaged survivors of trauma from sources such as grief, abuse, neglect, violence, addiction, and human trafficking. Lost Voices has worked in facilities across Michigan, including Vista Maria, Wedgwood Christian Services, Oakland Children's Village, Methodist Children's Home Society New Hope, and others. Mike was named a 2023 CNN Hero for his nearly two decades of work with these young people.
